The cost will be split with the Solon Library that will also have the Shark Tank for part of the day. A cultural program by Iowa Humanities that features people with unique stories has been applied for by Lauren and will be in July.

**Virtual WebJunction Children's Courses** - Lauren has signed up for several continuing education classes through WebJunction.

**Oxford Library Strategic Plan** - The Oxford Library Strategic Plan was revised per the board's input at our special meeting. A motion was made and seconded by Ruden/Spratt to approve the revised Oxford Library Strategic Plan.
